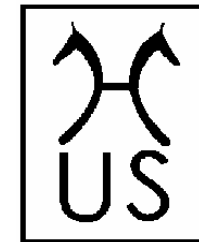

Paperwork Requirements

Please send in your registration forms to Hilltop Farm as early as possible, as stabling and other services fill quickly. See the attached Hilltop form to notify us of your inspection plans and register for any services offered by Hilltop. A few additional forms are required for horses incoming to Hilltop and will be sent to you upon your registration form being received. Payment for services rendered by Hilltop Farm must be sent in with the attached Hilltop registration form.

All horses being presented also must register with the AHS office via a separate registration form found on their website. AHS registration fees are due prior to the day of inspection.

Mares

Mailed prior to inspection:

- AHS enrollment form & AHS fees
- Copy of registration papers (if a non-Hanoverian mare)

Required the day of the inspection:

- Original registration papers

Foals

Mailed prior to inspection:

- AHS enrollment form & AHS fees

Required the day of the inspection:

- AHS registration form
- 4 color photographs of foal showing markings and all 4 sides
- Copy of the mare's registration papers
- Stallion service certificate if not already on file with AHS office

\$45.00/day	Daily stabling fee
\$45.00	Braiding for individual stallion/mare/foal <i>(Please make sure manes are pulled no longer than 4")</i>
\$75.00	Braiding for mare & foal
\$40.00	Handling for the mare or young horse
\$50.00	Handler for the mare and foal together

**If braiding services are requested, please note you must arrive at least 1 1/2 hours prior to your scheduled presentation time.*
